

## 4-H Indoor Exhibits – 2025 Exhibit Revisions

Changes have been made to sections of the 4-H Achievement Day Exhibit Classes. Below is a summary of the changes made. Please be sure to refer to the “Otero County 4-H Achievement Day Indoor 4-H Projects Exhibits Rules and Class Descriptions” for the requirements of each project and exhibit class.

### Personal Growth & Development-

- For class 515 (Uniquely NM Project), an additional description has been added for the Pinata exhibit: Pinata using technique from the project book (ex; star or donkey)
- New class added: Class 516: Any Pinata using other technique

### Creative Arts-

- The Intermediate Braiding & Knotting – Unit II project has been revised in 2025. For this year only, 4-H members may enter exhibits (classes 726-731) utilizing the standards included in either the old, 2022, version of the Unit II project, or the new, 2025, version of the Unit II project. Also, for this year only, class 734 (Unit 2 Exhibit Board) has been added.
- For class 1035 (Scrapbooking Project), the exhibit is no longer a digital scrapbook, instead the exhibit is as follows: *Two scrapbook pages in digital format – printed scrapbook using online scrapbooking software.*

### Home Economics-

- A class for Self-Determined Yeast Breads has been added: Class 1321- Self-Determined yeast bread exhibit.
- The Pastries and Pies project has been revised in 2025. Three new classes have been added for the Pastries and Pies project:  
Class 1322- Two Apple Green Chile empanadas  
Class 1323- Apricot pastelitos – three 2” x 2” squares  
Class 1324- A viscosity display including experiment result sheets and line spread viscometer, laminated or enclosed in plastic cover.

### Arts & Crafts-

- For classes 1819-1824 (Hobby Crafts) additional guidelines have been added for Lego kit exhibits: *Lego kit exhibits must have sturdy base other than the one included with Legos. Extension will not provide material for bases. Secure Legos to a base to prevent Legos from coming apart or falling off when moved. Entries may not be larger than 12” wide x 18” long x 16” high. Entries will not be accepted if larger than specified size, NO EXCEPTIONS.*

**Family Life-**

- The Understanding Preschool Children project has been revised in 2025. Two new classes have been added for the Understanding Preschool Children project:  
Class 1898- Display of how to choose foods for a preschooler  
Class 1899- DIY Early Childhood toy with information sheet  
The description for class 1900 has been revised: Display showing safe and unsafe toys for young children
