

4-H Indoor Exhibits – 2024 Exhibit Revisions

Animal Science-

- The following classes have been deleted:

- For class 106: Floral Arrangement, flowers are to be grown by 4-H member
- A new class has been added, class 180: Floral Arrangement using purchased flowers, greenery, etc. and must include Project Information Sheet
- The following class has been deleted:

Natural Science-

- The following classes have been deleted:
Class 221: Completed Rifle Member Record (Project) Book

Personal Growth & Development-

- For class 424, additional requirements have been added to include: Video of Speech to include a one-page document to display which includes title of speech, name, county, age division and 5 x 7 picture of member presenting speech in addition to jump drive.
- For class 430, additional requirements have been added to include: Digital Story with a 4-H Theme (include a one-page document to display which includes title of digital story, name, county, age division and 5x7 picture of a slide, screenshot, link, QR code, etc. of your story in addition to jump drive)
- For class 431, additional requirements have been added to include: Digital story with a non-4-H Theme (include a one-page document to display which includes title of digital story, name, county, age division and 5x7 picture of a slide, screenshot, link, QR code, etc. of your story in addition to jump drive)
- For class 524: Craft of Your Choice using a recycled boot, the boot must be deconstructed or altered from original state.
- The following class has been deleted:
Class 520: Trail Mix (1/2 pint jar)

Creative Arts-

- For all Needlepoint, Classes (813-181), the requirement of “completed project record sheet” has been replaced with “completed Project Information Sheet”.
- For Crochet, a new class has been added, class 824: Other item not in project book – Must include Project Information Sheet
- For Macrame, the following classes have been revised:
Class 825: Unit 1 – Once small article illustrating square and half hitch knots and their variations and completed Project Information Sheet
Class 826: Unit 2 – One article using different knots or knot variations of different types of yarn or cord and completed Project Information Sheet
Class 827: Unit 3 – Article of original design with chart and completed Project Information Sheet
- For 4-H Weaving, the following class has been added:
Class 835: Other Item not in book – Must submit Project Information Sheet
- For Photography, size of background for a Panorama photo has been added. And, the following classes have been revised:
Class 1008: Unit 1 – Photo with Completed Scorecard – Use scorecard from Photography Project Book. Mount photo with caption and scorecard on an 8” x 10” backing.

Class 1010: Unit 2 – Panorama Photo – a single image comprised of at least 3 individual images, placed end-to-end. Or a single image taken using the Panorama setting in-camera.

Class 1022: Unit 3 – Create a Photo Joiner include Title – mounting size no larger than an 11” x 14”.

Class 1023: Unit 2 – Color photo converted to black and white – original and black and white photo must be mounted on the same display

- For Scrapbooking, the following class has been added:
1035: one completed digital scrapbook – printed scrapbook using online digital scrapbooking software
- For Duded Up Denim class 1046: Any other item from the project book, a Project Information Sheet must be included.
- For Jewelry, the following class has been added:
1058: Jewelry Item not in project book – Must include Project Information Sheet
- For Origami class 1076: Origami Item not in project manual, a Project Information Sheet must be included.

Home Economics-

- For Serger Sewing class 1180: Advanced garment, a Project Information Sheet must be included.
- For Quilting I classes, approximate sizes of quilts have been added.
- For the new Quilting II project, classes have been added.
- The following classes have been deleted:
Class 1209: Completed project workbook (Quick Meals)
Class 1308: Three (3) Brown Sugar Nut Cookies (Baking II)
- For the Baking II project, the following class has been added:
Class 1308: Three (3) Cranberry Orange Refrigerator Cookies
- For Cake Decorating Exhibit Classes, a new recommendation of taking a picture of your final decorated cake and providing it with your cake to have it available to show judges in case of mishaps and/or heat effects during transportation has been added. Also, recipes utilizing alcohol are ineligible.
- For the Baking Self-Determined Class (1360), recipes utilizing alcohol are ineligible.
- For the Boiling Water Bath Canning Classes (1506-1516), recipes utilizing alcohol are ineligible.

Consumer Education & Home Management-

- For Housing and Interior Design Classes (1608-1612), the requirement of “an 8½ x 11 sheet detailing techniques used, skill learned and purpose of item” has been replaced with “Must include Project Information Sheet”.

Arts & Crafts-

- For Arts, classes have been expanded to include eight new classes. The new classes include several different artistic mediums: acrylic, crayon/marker, ink/pencil/ mixed media, oil, pastels, watercolor, and miscellaneous.
- For Crafts, classes have been expanded to include eight new classes. The new classes include several different craft mediums: fabric, glass, leather, metal, sculpture, wreaths, wood, and miscellaneous.
- For Hobby Crafts, classes have been expanded to include ten new classes. The new Hobby Crafts classes are Exhibits that utilize a kit, such as models, Legos or miscellaneous.

Family Life- No changes.
