

4-H Indoor Exhibits – 2026 Exhibit Revisions

Changes have been made to sections of the 4-H Achievement Day Exhibit Classes. Below is a summary of the changes made. Please be sure to refer to the “Otero County 4-H Achievement Day Indoor 4-H Projects Exhibits Rules and Class Descriptions” for the requirements of each project and exhibit class. Adjustments include clarifications to class descriptions, new class numbers, and other necessary modifications.

Additionally, the Self-Determined Project Record Sheet (300.SD.1) and Project Information Sheet forms have been revised. Copies of the forms may be downloaded from the [Otero County Extension Service website](#).

Creative Arts:

- **Leathercraft:** Clarified the leathercraft exhibit requirements. The project book requires youth to use four specific stamps for the project. An additional class (#719) has been added to allow youth to submit leathercraft projects using a variety of stamps. (This class was placed under Unit III due to available class numbering.)
- **Braiding:** Intermediate Unit II (Green Cover Version), Class 734, has replaced Intermediate Unit II (Red Cover Version). Classes 726–731 have been omitted.
- **Macramé:** Exhibits previously listed under Braiding Intermediate Unit II (Red Cover Version) have been moved to the Macramé section. Omitted classes 825-827. New classes added: 828–833.
- **Knitting:** Classes 837–847 include new exhibits from the recently revised project book. New exhibit examples include finger knitting, loom knitting, and additional techniques. (Macramé classes were renumbered to 828–833 to accommodate these updates.) Omitted Classes 825-827 to reflect the new curriculum.
- **4-H Weaving:** Classes have been renumbered to begin at 850–854 (previously 832–836).

Family Consumer Sciences (formerly Home Economics):

- **Sewing I:** Added Class 1099: “Waist No Time Apron” from the additional pattern from Sewing I book.
- **Let’s Make a T-shirt:** Omitted Class 1118: “Let’s Make A T-shirt”.

Food & Nutrition:

- **Milk Unit I:** Added Classes to the Dairy Food: Milk Unit I. Replaced 1400 for Dairy Foods I Exhibit of your choice (non-food item). Replaced 1401 with Three (3) Oatmeal Cookies. Replace 1402 with Lotion made from Milk. Added 1402A Soap Made from milk.

Family Life:

- **Understanding Infants and Toddlers:** Added new exhibit classes from the curriculum, *Understanding Infants and Toddlers* (Classes 1890–1893).
- **Generation celebration:** Renumbered *Generation Celebration* exhibits to incorporate new exhibits from the recently revised project book (Classes 1902–1906). Three classes included in the revised book were not listed in the previous project book.
- **Babysitting Basics:** *Babysitting Basics* exhibits have been renumbered and will now begin with Classes 1920–1926.
